Dear PPCR Sub-Committee Members,

Please find attached a request for a PPCR allocation of US\$25,000 for project implementation and supervision services for the project entitled, *Bangladesh - Climate Change Capacity Building and Knowledge Management*, submitted by the Asian Development Bank (ADB) for your review and approval.

The Bangladesh SPCR was endorsed by the PPCR Sub-Committee in November 2010, with US\$25,000 (50%) of the estimated project implementation and supervision services of US\$50,000, being approved at that time.

During its meeting in June 2011, the SCF Trust Fund committee approved document SCF/TFC.7/6, *MDB Project Implementation Services under SCF's Targeted Programs – Sources of Funding and Implementation Arrangement*.

The project entitled, *Bangladesh - Climate Change Capacity Building and Knowledge Management*, was approved by the PPCR Sub-Committee meeting in June 2011. The request for the final MPIS payment was not submitted at the time of the request for project funding, and as a consequence, it is being submitted for approval at this time.

The PPCR Sub-Committee is requested to approve the following decision:

The PPCR Sub-Committee approves a PPCR allocation of US\$25,000 for the implementation and supervision services for the project entitled, *Bangladesh - Climate Change Capacity Building and Knowledge Management*, submitted by the Asian Development Bank (ADB).

For your information the following table summarizes the allocation of PPCR resources for project implementation and supervision services for the project entitled, *Bangladesh - Climate Change Capacity Building and Knowledge Management*. The Trustee has confirmed that there are sufficient resources available for commitment of the resources requested.
